

## **Are You Terrified Fruitless of Torah**

For those who question, worry, or wonder, whether the Torah (Law) of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) Our Creator should still be obeyed; for those who have been boxed into a corner, shuddering in fear, by those who would bully and taunt them with warnings against keeping the Torah (Law) lest they lose their salvation: This message is for you.

I am aware that the norm in an article such as this is that I, the author, present you with an argument and evidences that my argument is true and factual. That is the norm, the commonly accepted, the status quo. You my friend, however, are not the norm. You do not fit the mold of what is commonly accepted, and you most certainly do not meet the status quo. You, my rather odd friend, are being called to be set-apart, separate, and singled out, from the rest of the so called normal, commonly accepted, meeting the status quo, folks of this world. You are being called to walk as a Natsarim, which means watchman, over the House of Israel. I will allow you to draw your own conclusions, and answer your own questions.....

Ezekiel 3:17 THE BESORAH Page 597 --"Son of man, **I have made you a watchman for the house of Yisra'ël.** And you shall hear a word from My mouth, and shall warn them from Me.

Puzzled? Allow a few passages of scripture to clarify and bring this reality into focus for you.....

Act 24:5 THE BESORAH Page 1186--"For having found this man a plague, who stirs up dissension among all the Yahudim throughout the world, and a ringleader of the **sect of the Natsarim.**

The disciples of Messiah were Natsarim, watchmen for the House of Israel. They were Natsarim because Messiah ׀ׁׂ׃ׂ (Yahusha) was a Natsarim as well.....

Mat 2:23 THE BESORAH Page 1022--and came and dwelt in a city called Natsareth – thus to fill what was spoken by the prophets, "**He shall be called a Natsarim.**"

Mat 15:24 THE BESORAH Page 1039--And He answering, said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of **the house of Yisra'ël.**"

The first and foremost commission given to His disciples by Messiah was.....

Mat 10:6 THE BESORAH Page 1031--but rather go to the lost sheep of **the house of Yisra'ël.**

As I shared with you a few moments ago, you are being called. Though I will offer assistance in sorting out your thoughts, the evidence of this call is not my argument, nor mine to prove. The evidence is within your own heart and witnessed to you by the fact that the very moment your heart and mind entertained the possibility that the Torah (Law) of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) Our Mighty One is to be obeyed your life changed from everything pretty much going your way in life, at home, work, church, and friends, to absolutely nothing going your way any longer. The instant you envisioned **that** possibility within your heart and mind you began to change sides in a spiritual war that is being waged upon this earth over the the lives and hearts of men, women, and children the world over.

The consequence: satan is coming at you with everything he can possibly wield to deter you from leaving his ranks: The ranks of the Torah-less; the ranks of the Lawless. Our adversary is a poor sport. Allow me to assure you of this very important fact: satan does not fight fair. This is the series of events which has brought you to where you are today. Your friends have begun to think of you as a nut, your church family considers you a bit of a heretic, possibly your own wife or husband believes that you may have lost it. Even things at work are not as grand as they use to be, as it seems that suddenly you have fallen somewhat from grace in the eyes of your employer and co-workers since you have begun acting to them so strangely, seeing things now in a different light. That previous light was darkness. That darkness dominates the minds of the majority of mankind, with the exception of those who are answering the call.

Will you answer the call? Have you been **given** ears to hear? Have you been **given** eyes to see? Will you meet the qualifications required of a Watchman? Will you pass the test? There is only one way to find out. Take the test, my friend. I will quietly look over your shoulder and assist all I can.....

### **The Watchman Quiz**

Please place an "X" in the appropriate box.

**Question:** Do you believe the words of Messiah **OWYAZL** (Yahusha)? Yes  NO .

I am going to step out on a limb here and assume that you placed your "X" in the "**Yes**" box.

Now, pressing on with that assumption let us look at a passage of scripture.....

**Mat 5:27-28 THE BESORAH Page 1025--** "You heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not commit adultery.' But I say to you that **everyone looking at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.**

**Question:** Do you believe this statement of Messiah **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) is true? Yes  No .

**Question:** a. Do you believe Messiah is condoning lustful thoughts? Yes  No .

b. Do you believe Messiah is condemning lustful thoughts? Yes  No .

Stepping a little further out on that limb I will again make an assumption: The assumption that you answered part "a." to the previous question **No** stating your belief that Messiah was not condoning lustful thoughts in this passage, and also assuming that you answered part "b." to the previous question **Yes** stating your belief that Messiah was indeed condemning lustful thoughts.

Let's test that limb upon which I am standing, check my assumption for accuracy. If your heart instructed you to answer **No** to part "a" of the previous question, and "**Yes**" to part "b", then your heart is in complete agreement with the Torah (Law) of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) Our Mighty One. Your heart is confessing that adultery **is** wrong whether it be adultery of the mind and imagination or adultery in the physical fleshly sense. Your heart is also confessing indisputably that Messiah **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) upheld His Father's Torah (Law) and therefore could not have done away with it as is commonly taught by the Church.

**Bonus question:** Do you believe that by striving to resist the temptation to commit adultery you are, in reality, attempting to work your way into the Kingdom of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) and earn your salvation based upon your works? Yes [ ] No [ ].

If you answered this bonus question **No**, then you have confirmed within your heart the very real and scriptural fact that obeying the Torah (Law) does not save you. It merely points out to us right from wrong. Torah (Law) was never intended to save us. It is the grace of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) Our Creator, His unlimited, boundless, kindness towards us, which has caused Him to offer His only Son as a sacrifice for our sins, and by whose blood we are saved. There was **never** any provision for the forgiveness of intentional sin, such as adultery, within the context of the Torah (Law). Only **unintentional** sin was addressed by the animal sacrifices of the Levitical Priesthood.

Is the proof truly in the pudding? Let us check the truth of what I have shared with you for scriptural accuracy.....

---

Num 15:30a & 31b KJV--But the soul that doeth *ought* **presumptuously**, whether he be born in the land, or a stranger.....that soul shall be cut off from among his people.....**that soul shall utterly be cut off; his iniquity shall be upon him.**

Num 15:30-31 THE BESORAH page 207--"But **the being who does whatever defiantly, whether he is native or a stranger, he reviles אַיָּהּ, and that being shall be cut off from among his people.** 'Because he has despised the word of אַיָּהּ and has broken His command, **that being shall certainly be cut off, his crookedness is upon him.'**"

Please take note that in both scripture translations the pronouncement of punishment is stated **twice**. This establishes a scriptural witness to the fact that this is indeed to be the punishment for any and every person who transgresses the Torah **willfully**.....

Deut 17:6 THE BESORAH Page 255--"**At the mouth of two or three witnesses shall he that is to die be put to death.** He is not put to death by the mouth of one witness.

Mat 18:16 THE BESORAH Page 1042--"But if he does not hear, take with you one or two more, that **'by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word might be established.'**

2Co 13:1 THE BESORAH Page 1233--This is the third time I am coming to you. "**By the mouth of two or three witnesses every word shall be established."**

The intentional sins which we have all committed had to be addressed by better promises. The purpose of Torah (Law) is simply to point us in that direction: That direction **is** **וְיָהוּשָׁע** (Yahusha) Messiah.

The establishment of witnesses is also touched upon by the writer of Hebrews, as the author makes it clear that if we choose to live a life of unrepentant sin after entering into the Renewed Covenant with Messiah **וְיָהוּשָׁע** (Yahusha) we will face a most certain and eternal destruction.....

Heb 10:26-29 THE BESORAH page 1277--For **if we sin purposely after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a slaughter offering for sins, but some fearsome anticipation of judgment, and a fierce fire which is about to consume the opponents. Anyone who has disregarded the Torah of Mosheh dies without compassion on the witness of two or three witnesses.** How much worse punishment do you think shall he deserve who has trampled the Son of Elohim underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was set apart as common, and insulted the Spirit of favour?

The Hebrew word Torah (Law) means "teaching", "instruction". In average Joe's terms, the Torah (Law) is **אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah's)** survival manual given to you and I to teach, train, and instruct us **for our good**; to protect us, not harm us; to set us free, not make us slaves; to bring us to Messiah, not bring us to destruction.

It is the desire of our Heavenly Father that we be set-apart (holy) and perfect, as we have been called (you are now being called) not only as Watchmen, but also to serve as Priests of **אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)** Our Mighty One.....

1Pe 2:9 THE BESORAH Page 1287--But **you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a set-apart nation**, a people for a possession, that you should proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvellous light,

Gen 17:1 THE BESORAH Page 57--And it came to be when Abram was ninety-nine years old, that **אֱלֹהִים** appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am **Ēl Shaddai** – **walk before Me and be perfect**

Psa 119:1 THE BESORAH Page 793--Blessed are the **perfect in the way, Who walk in the Torah of אֱלֹהִים!**

Mat 5:48 THE BESORAH Page 1026--"Therefore, **be perfect, as your Father** in the heavens **is perfect**.

Does it seem strange that the people chosen by Our Heavenly Father as perfect, set-apart (holy), Priests and Watchmen should be asked to live their lives in obedience to a code of conduct **worthy** of that calling, **worthy** of the debt to which we owe our Messiah **וְיָהוּשָׁע (Yahusha)**, and can never hope to repay?

Doesn't every child wish to be like his Father? Why are we taught differently within the Church? Why are we taught that to strive to be obedient and perfect as our Father is perfect is wrong? Is it not natural for every child to desire to please and receive a "well done" from his Father?

Is it unreasonable to say that the grace poured upon us through **וְיָהוּשָׁע (Yahusha)** Messiah's shed blood should instill **within us** a sense of overwhelming love and thankfulness for the one who purchased us with His own life and with His own blood? If scripture points out to us that we have been purchased by Messiah **וְיָהוּשָׁע (Yahusha)** through His sacrifice, then **are we not** His property to command as He sees fit?

1Co 6:19 THE BESORAH Page 1213--Or do you not know that your body is the Dwelling Place of the Set-apart Spirit who is in you, which you have from Elohim, and **you are not your own? For you were bought with a price, therefore esteem Elohim in your body and in your spirit, which are of Elohim.**

---

1Co 7:22 THE BESORAH Page 1214--For he who is called in the Master while a slave is the Master's freed man. Likewise **he who is called while free is a slave of Messiah. You were bought with a price**, do not become slaves of men.

You see my friend, grace has not replaced or done away with the Torah (Law). In fact, quite the contrary is true, as nothing **could be** further from the truth. It is Torah (Law) **which has brought us to grace**: **אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah's)** limitless, boundless, kindness towards us. Torah (Law) points us towards Messiah. If we walk in obedience to Torah (Law), then we are walking **towards Messiah, towards אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah's) grace** which **is** His limitless, boundless, kindness towards us.

Sadly, the other side of the coin is this: If we do not answer the call, and we choose to walk in disobedience to Torah (Law), then we are walking **away from Messiah, away from אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah's) grace**, away from His limitless, boundless, kindness towards us. The end result is death...**final** and **eternal** death.....

Heb 10:29 THE BESORAH Page 1277--**How much worse punishment do you think shall he deserve who has trampled the Son of Elohim underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was set apart as common, and insulted the Spirit of favour?**

Rom 6:23 THE BESORAH Page 1198--**For the wages of sin is death**, but the favourable gift of Elohim is everlasting life in Messiah **OWYAZL** our Master.

I know without any doubt that you are being assailed daily, unceasingly, without rest, by friends, family, and co-workers who believe that you have gone astray. You are no longer with them in the walk which they are walking. They may be angry at you, hurt and confused, because they strongly desire to pull you back into the mold in which they have encased themselves, while blindly and unquestioningly recanting to you the Torah-less (Lawless) teaching of the Church which stands in direct opposition to the word of **AYAZL (Yahuah)** Our Mighty One. These concerned, but misled people, whom satan is using to attack you relentlessly, have been deceptively convinced that the Torah (Law) has been done away with. This is the daily battle which is being waged within your heart. This is the war which is being fought between the forces of **AYAZL (Yahuah)** and the forces of satan over your eternal destination. satan does not want you to pass this test, answer this call.

If at this point you remain in a state of doubt and uncertainty don't just sit there, stand up and fight. Go on.....Put this Church doctrine of demons to the test. If the Torah has indeed been done away with, then go ahead and commit adultery; go ahead and murder; go ahead and steal. If these people are correct, then these things are no longer wrong to commit, and are no longer considered sin.

The sensible, logical, "don't be stupid dummy", test? Ask these folks if they believe that adultery, murder, and stealing is wrong. If they say no, then perhaps the Torah has been done away with. On the other hand, if they alarmingly tell you, "yes, these things are sinful and wrong", then by the witness of their own mouths they are confessing that the Torah (Law) of **AYAZL (Yahuah)** continues to exist, continues to be in effect, and should be obeyed. Adultery, murder, and stealing are the 7th, 6th, and 8<sup>th</sup> commands of the Ten Commandments. The Ten Commandments are the very **foundation** of the Torah (Law) which those programmed and deceived by the Church claim has been done away with by Messiah. If that is so, there is no longer any such thing **as** sin.

Rom 7:7 THE BESORAH Page 1199--What, then, shall we say? Is the Torah sin? Let it not be! However, **I did not know sin except through the Torah. For also the covetousness I knew not if the Torah had not said, "You shall not covet."**

1Jn 3:4 KJV--Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for **sin is the transgression of the law.**

Why is that? Because, if Torah (Law) has been done away with, the teaching and instructions which point out to us exactly what **is** sin has been done away with as well. Sin **is** the violation of Torah (Law). If your concerned friends and family are correct, then anything goes. Whatever pleases you **do it**, for tomorrow, like an animal, you die and return to the dust. Without the Torah (Law) there is nothing to point or guide the way to Messiah; no gauge from which to measure right and wrong, and thus **drive us** to the inevitable conclusion of our desperate need of a Savior.

Let's finish this test with a few last thoughts well worth pondering over. If it were true that Messiah **OWYAZL (Yahusha)** did away with His Father's Torah (Law), then His death upon the stake served no purpose at all. Without Torah (Law) there **is** no reckoning of sin. There is **nothing**, therefore, to draw any of us to Messiah; nothing to be forgiven for; nothing for the Set-Apart Spirit (Holy Spirit) to convict us of.

Rom 5:13 THE BESORAH Page 1197--for until the Torah, sin was in the world, but **sin is not reckoned when there is no Torah.**

---

Rom 5:13 KJRV--for until the law sin was in the world: but **sin is not imputed when there is no law.**

---

Your heart within you testifies against this lie of the spirit of anti-messiah which is deceiving all who do not desire to hear and know the truth. As we discussed earlier, if your friends, family, or co-workers confess to you that they believe adultery, murder, and stealing are wrong and sinful, then they are confessing that Torah (Law) still stands, and is to be obeyed. They are simply practicing the doctrine of "pick and choose" picking for themselves what they will choose to believe and obey. Their confession contains another important piece of information as well: They are being called just as you are but, at this point in their lives, their answer to date has been no. Sadly, they have no idea what shaky ground they have chosen to stand upon.....

2Th 2:9-12 THE BESORAH Page 1258-1259--The coming of the *lawless one* is according to the working of Satan, with all power and signs and wonders of falsehood, and with all deceit of unrighteousness in those perishing, **because they did not receive the love of the truth**, in order for them to be saved. And for this reason Elohim **sends them a working of delusion, for them to believe the falsehood**, in order that all should be judged **who did not believe the truth, but have delighted in the unrighteousness.**

This is your opportunity to score highly on this test, to win the prize of eternal life. Please do not rush past these last few questions in haste. Your heart is already confirming within you that the Ten commandments are still in effect. Therefore, the Torah (Law), which is founded upon those commandments, **is in effect** as well. Do you know, my friend, **who** the Torah is? This is a most important question. This is the one which, if answered and obeyed correctly, could win you that mansion in the Kingdom of Messiah **OWYAZL (Yahusha).**

Question: Do you believe that the Torah (Law) **is the Word** of **AYAZL (Yahuah)** Our Mighty One?

Psa 119:72 THE BESORAH Page 795--The **Torah of Your mouth** is better to me Than thousands of gold and silver pieces.

Question: Do you believe that Messiah **OWYAZL (Yahusha)** **is the Word**? Yes [] No[]

Joh 1:1 THE BESORAH Page 1123--In the beginning was **the Word**, and **the Word was with Elohim, and the Word was Elohim.**

If you answered yes to these two questions then please accept this fact: **OWYAZL (Yahusha)** is **the living Torah** (Law), **the Word of AYAZL (Yahuah)**. Why would He then, do away with Himself.....?

You have heard the evidence and testimony of your own heart. If you answered no to these last two questions and your own heart cannot sway you, then in all honesty no one can. I have heard the call of **AYAZL (Yahuah)**. I was compelled to answer, and I am also compelled to shout the warning as He has commanded me, lest your blood be upon my hands. You too, are being called. Will you stand before Him one day with blood upon your hands; the blood of those you were called to warn, but your answer was no? Ezekiel 33:1-7 THE BESORAH Page 631--And the word of **AYAZL** came to me saying, "Son of man, speak to the children of your people, and you shall say to them, 'When I bring the sword upon a land, and the people of the land shall take a man from their borders and **shall make him their watchman**, and **he sees the sword coming upon the land, and shall blow the ram's horn and shall warn the**

**people**, then whoever shall hear the sound of the ram's horn and shall not take warning, if the sword comes and takes him away, his blood is on his own head. 'He heard the sound of the ram's horn, but he did not take warning, his blood is on himself. But he who takes warning shall deliver his being. 'But **if the watchman sees the sword coming and shall not blow the ram's horn, and the people shall not be warned, and the sword comes and takes any being from among them, he is taken away in his crookedness, and his blood I require at the watchman's hand.**' "And you, son of man, **I have made you a watchman for the house of Yisra'el. And you shall hear a word from My mouth and you shall warn them for Me.**

In closing I leave you with some passages of scripture which speak of Torah (Law).

Psa 78:1 THE BESORAH Page 766--My people, **give ear to my Torah**, Incline your ears **to the words of my mouth**.

Psa 1:1-2 THE BESORAH Page 721-- Blessed is the man who shall not walk in the counsel of the wrong, And shall not stand in the path of sinners, And shall not sit in the seat of scoffers, **But his delight is in the Torah of אִשְׁרָאֵל, And he meditates in His Torah day and night.**

Psa 19:7 THE BESORAH Page730-- **The Torah is אִשְׁרָאֵל is perfect**, bringing back the being; The witness of אִשְׁרָאֵל is trustworthy, making wise the simple;

Psa 94:12 THE BESORAH Page778-- Blessed is the man You discipline, O Yah, And **instruct out of Your Torah**,

Psa 119:18 THE BESORAH Page794-- Open my eyes, that I might see **Wonders from Your Torah**.

Pro 28:9 THE BESORAH Page 837-- **He who turns away his ear from hearing the Torah, Even his prayer is an abomination.**
