Is A Pig A Pork Who Makes A Hog Of Himself While Behaving Like A Swine?

Many and numerous articles have been written on the topic of clean versus unclean foods. I am certain we all know someone, somewhere, who consumes unclean things as a regular part of their diet. I recently forwarded an e-mail document on Pig Facts to my friends and brothers in Messiah Yahusha. Receiving Illogical Logic: The answer you will receive to all three questions is that Jesus did away with the Law, and also declared all foods clean. Shockingly this very same person will respond **totally illogically**, ignoring the Prophets which foretell that **on the Day of Yahuah—Judgment Day—Yahuah will destroy all whom He finds eating unclean things such as Pork, Pig, Hog, and Swine**.

<u>render His displeasure with burning</u>, and His rebuke with flames of fire. "For by fire and by His sword shall judge all flesh, and the slain of יהוה shall be many – those who set themselves apart and cleanse themselves at the gardens after 'One' in the midst, eating flesh of pigs and the abomination and the mouse, are snatched away, together,"

Applied Logic: Let us apply some logic of our own and submit it to our Christian brother.

Mat 5:18-19 THE SCRIPTURES--"For truly, **I** say to you, till the heaven and the earth pass away, one jot or one tittle shall by no means pass from the Torah till all be done. "Whoever, then, breaks one of the least of these commands, and teaches men so, shall be called least in the reign of the heavens; but whoever does and teaches them, he shall be called great in the reign of the heavens.

Brick Parrish, author of the book Study of the Two House Restoration of Israel, would answer our Christian brother with the passage above, and politely point out: "Heaven and Earth are still here aren't they? Then from this overwhelming and obvious fact, we can only reach the logical conclusion that the Law—Torah--must still be in effect and should be obeyed."

Where do we see, in this famed and often quoted passage, the mention of Jesus declaring all foods clean. We see nothing of the sort. Why? Because the statement of Jesus declaring all foods clean was-never a part of the original text, but was instead a personal comment made by a previous translator and placed in brackets or parenthesis. When the Geneva and King James translations were printed the translators took note of this fact, and so did not include this previous persons personal notation in the text of their work of translating the Scriptures. In fact, this text has nothing at all to do with a discussion of what is food and what is not food—kosher—but whether or not a man failing to wash his hands in a particular ceremonial manner defiles him or not. The conversation concluded with Messiah sharing that it is not dirt or filth going into a man that defiles him, but that it is what comes out of a man—his heart and mind—that defiles him before the Almighty.

Deu 18:20-22 THE SCRIPTURES--'But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in My Name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other mighty ones, even that prophet shall die.' "And when you say in your heart, 'How do we know the word which יהוה has not spoken?' — when the prophet speaks in the Name of יהוה and the word is not, or comes not, that is the word which יהוה has not spoken. The prophet has spoken it presumptuously. Do not be afraid of him.

Logical Conclusion: If Jesus did away with the Law, then the Prophet Isaiah was a false Prophet who lied and spoke falsely. He was, therefore, worthy of death. Gen 2:15-17 THE SCRIPTURES—And יהוה Elohim took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to work it and to guard it. And יהוה Elohim commanded the man, saying, "Eat of every tree of the garden, but do not eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for in the day that you eat of it you shall certainly die."
